Cybersecurity

Prepare for a job in cybersecurity. Learn digital security skills used to protect critical systems and sensitive information from digital attacks. This course is designed to provide the student with the necessary knowledge and skills to become an entry-level cybersecurity technician within the networking and information communications industry.

Class meets: **Mon & Wed from 4:00 pm to 6:30 pm in Room S3**

Dental Assistant

Dental Assistants work in dental offices under licensed dentists. Students will learn chairside assisting in general dentistry procedures. Classroom instruction includes dental terminology, x-rays, instrument sterilization, and preparation of dental materials. An x-ray certificate will be issued upon completion of the course.

120 hours of required internship at local dental offices will be arranged with the instructor.

Emergency Medical Technician

Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) work in emergency rooms, and public or private ambulance services while performing critical interventions to patients in need. Students will learn prehospital care skills, introduction to emergency medical care, triage, human anatomy, lifting and transporting patients, airway management, and ambulance operations. 24 ride-along internship hours are required. Students who successfully complete the course will be eligible to participate in the National Registration Examination.

Medical Assistant

Students will learn vital signs, injections, venipuncture, infection control, in-office laboratory testing, billing, terminology, records filing, and reception. Medical Assistants work in all areas of a physician's office or medical groups. 144 hours of required internship at local doctors' offices or healthcare centers will be arranged with the instructor.

Medical Assistant*

**This class is offered for students in the English Language Learner Healthcare Pathways. Students need to be co-enrolled in this free CTE class and the free AESL class offered through Saddleback College.*

Students will learn vital signs, injections, venipuncture, infection control, in-office laboratory testing, billing, terminology, records filing, and reception. Medical Assistants work in all areas of a physician's office or medical groups. 144 hours of required internship at local doctors' offices or healthcare centers will be arranged with the instructor.

Class meets: Tue & Thurs from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm and Fri 8:00 am to 4:00 pm in Room P-16

Pharmacy Technician

Pharmacy Technicians work in a hospital or retail pharmacy. Instruction includes dosage calculations, over-the-counter medications, labeling medications, pharmacy procedures, HIPAA requirements, and IV preparation. Students must pass a background check performed by the State Board of Pharmacy and hold a high school diploma or GED. 240 hours of internship will be arranged with the instructor.

Class meets: Mon, Tu, Wed, Thur. from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm in Room P-15



Surgical Technologist

Surgical Technologists work alongside surgeons in the operating room. Students will learn instrument tray setup for various types of surgery, equipment and room preparation, techniques and procedures used during surgeries, human anatomy, operating room preparation, and surgical instruments. The class runs for 27 weeks. an additional 500 hours of internship is required after successful completion of classroom instruction.

Class meets: **Mon, Tu, Wed, Thur. from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm in Room P-18 & P-20**

Veterinary Technician - Alternate Route

Veterinary Technicians are supervised by licensed veterinarians who perform medical tests to help diagnose animals' illnesses and injuries. Depending on the work environment, a vet tech job description may include care, clinical, and laboratory tasks. State-required hours of clinic or hospital experience will be needed to be eligible as a Registered Veterinary Technician. Students are responsible for acquiring state-required hours.
